

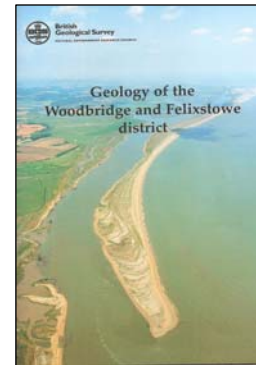
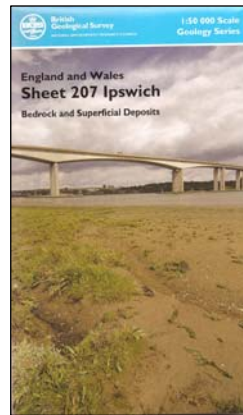
# BRITISH GEOLOGICAL SURVEY
