

## CRAGGY NAMES

GeoSuffolk Notes  
#43.

### TATTINGSTONE

- 'Crag Pit Farm' - with sign at start of track to farm.
- 'Crag Pit Cottage' - near Reservoir.
- 'Crag Hall' - now no more, because of Reservoir  
- also 'Crag Hall Covert' and 'Crag Hall Wood'.

### FELIXSTOWE

- 'Crag Pit Nursery'.

### NEWBOURN

- 'Crag Cottage'.

### WALDRINGFIELD

- 'The Craggs', School Road.

### MELTON

- 'Crag Pit Wood'.

### RAMSHOLT

- the wood by the church is 'Crag Pit Wood'.

### ALDERTON

- 'Crag Pit Hill' (sometimes called 'Crag Hill'), on the road to Ramsholt.

### BOYTON

- 'Crag Farm', with sign at start of track to farm.

### SUDBOURNE

- 'Crag Farm' and 'Crag Farm Road'; also road-sign.
- 'Crag Pit Cottage'.

### ALDEBURGH

- 'Crag Pit House' (formerly 'Crag Pit Farm')
- 'Crag Pit Nursery', now no more.
- 'Crag House', by Moot Green  
- Benjamin Britten lived there 1947-1957 (see plaque on house).
- 'Crag Cottage' (no. 21 Crobbe Street).
- 'Crag Path'; 'Crag' named houses are '10 Crag Path', no. 63, and at the rear (in King Street) nos. 24, 32, 40, 43, 47 and 61.  
- even dustbins get a look in, see '22 C.P.' and '31 C.P.'

### SIZEWELL/ALDRINGHAM THORPE

- 'Crag Cottage' (thanks to Martin Sanford for this one).

### WALTON-ON-THE-NAZE, ESSEX

- 'Crag Walk'.
